



Affidavit of Financial Support for International Students (L.A. Campus)

All students who require an M-1 or F-1 visa are required by U.S. government regulations to provide financial documentation showing available liquid funds to support their tuition, fees, and living expenses for the duration of their program of study in the U.S.

The total support amount must be equal or greater than the amount shown on the I-20. Financial documentation of adequate liquid funds must be submitted in the form of a recent (within the last 3 months) bank statement or other financial documentation (loan statement, government funds, certificate of credit) and must include the sponsor's name. An I-20 CANNOT be issued until proof of adequate funds is provided. If you are receiving government sponsorship, a letter of support stating the exact terms and length of the scholarship including any provisions must be provided.

Amounts Based on Program of Study

Living Expenses are estimated at \$2,500 per month. This is a conservative estimate using shared housing. Students may spend more than that depending on their spending habits and housing arrangements.

The amounts below must be demonstrated in order for The Lee Strasberg Theatre & Film Institute to issue an I-20 and to obtain a student visa. These amounts include tuition costs, fees, plus the estimated living expenses of \$2,500 a month. A Student Tuition Recovery Fund (STRF) fee is added to the tuition for every student studying in California.

12-Week Session (M-1 visa)

$\$8,000 + \$7,500 = \$15,500$

One-Year Conservatory (M-1 visa)

$\$23,225 + \$22,500 = \$45,725$

Two-Year Conservatory (M-1 visa)

$\$23,225 + \$22,500 = \$45,725$ (Sufficient funds for 1st year of study must be demonstrated. You do not need to show sufficient funds for the length of the entire program.)

Associate of Occupational Studies (F-1 visa)

$\$32,020 + \$22,500 = \$54,520$ (Sufficient funds for 1st year of study must be demonstrated. You do not need to show sufficient funds for the length of the entire program.)

The tuition deposit, inclusive of non-refundable registration fee (\$250), must be paid prior to I-20 issuance
****Registration fee will be refunded if visa is denied. Visa denial documentation must be submitted with refund request form***
